What does Readily Biodegradable Surfactants mean?

The Readily Biodegradable Surfactants symbol reflects that the product has changed to incorporate biodegradable surfactants, replacing alkylphenol ethoxylates (APEO's).



Surfactants are used in a variety of applications including fabric cleaners, surface cleaners, and other detergent formulations. The term "surfactant" means "surface active agent". Many surfactants give rise to environmental concerns due to their poor biodegradability, their toxicity and their potential to act as endocrine disrupters.



What is DfE?

Design for the Environment works with environmental organizations and industry to protect human health and promote sustainable chemistry.

DfE's Safer Product Labeling Program helps to protect the environment by distinguishing household and cleaning products, like soaps, detergents, and cleaners, that are safer for people and the planet. EPA's scientific team rigorously evaluates each product for its impact on both human and environmental health.

The DfE label means a product works well and is made with the safest possible chemicals.

EPA allows safer products to carry the Design for the Environment (DfE) label. This mark allows consumers to quickly identify and choose products that can help protect the environment and are safer for the environment.

When you see the DfE logo on a product it means that the DfE scientific review team has screened each ingredient for potential human health and environmental effects based on currently available information, EPA predictive models, and expert judgment. The product contains only those ingredients that pose the least concern among chemicals in their class.

Product manufacturers who become DfE partners, and earn the right to display the DfE logo on recognized products, have invested heavily in research, development and reformulation to ensure that their ingredients and finished product line up on the green end of the health and environmental spectrum, while maintaining or improving product performance.
